DESCRIPTION

Johnstone's StainAway is an innovative, high opacity wall and ceiling paint. It contains Stain Blocking Technology, permanently isolating even the most persistent stains such as smoke damage, nicotine damage and water stains. Johnstone's StainAway is a stain sealer and finish in one product. It has a dead flat finish that hides surface imperfections, whilst providing a high level of durability achieving class 1 scrub rating ISO 11998.

RECOMMENDED USES



Stain isolator and finish for all types of interior walls and ceilings both bare and previously painted including plaster, plasterboard, concrete, ceiling tiles and wallcoverings.

Gives the same stain blocking performance when applied to a variety of suitably prepared and primed surfaces such as metal, wood, melamine, glazed tiles etc.

Apply all-purpose cleaner to sponge or soft cloth and wipe away stain from surface and allow to dry.

PREPARATION

All surfaces to be painted should be clean, dry and free from loose and flaking material. Rub down previously painted surfaces with fine waterproof abrasive paper and rinse thoroughly. Where water damage has occurred, ensure the leak is fixed and the area is dry before painting. If severe remove heavy nicotine, soot and smoke deposits as much as possible, in keeping with basic painting practices. Avoid the inhalation of dust. Wear a suitable face mask if dry sanding. APPLICATION



Ensure good ventilation during application and drying. Stir well. Easy to apply by brush and roller. Also suitable for application by spray. Avoid over spreading. Some strong or contrasting stains may require a further coats. Seal absorbent surfaces such as new plaster, plaster boards filler etc. with a coat of StainAway thinned up to 10% with clean water. For alternative surfaces such as wood, metal melamine, tiles etc. use the appropriate Johnstone's Primer. Ensure good ventilation during application and drying. Do not apply in temperatures below 8°C or in damp conditions. Spray Application: AIRLESS SPRAY: Un-thinned: Spray @ 2000 PSI / 207 bar with 517 tip.

CLEANING



Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Replace lid firmly. Clean equipment immediately after use with warm soapy water and rinse thoroughly. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.

PRECAUTIONS

- Contains 1,2-benzisothiazol-3(2H)-one and 2-methyl-2H-isothiazol-3-one. May produce an allergic reaction.
- If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not breathe spray. Wear respiratory protection.
- Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.
- IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing.
- IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of water. Do not use solvent thinners or White Spirit.
- IF SWALLOWED: Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor if you feel unwell.
