Brush, Roller, Spray Ensure products are thoroughly stirred with a broad stirrer prior to use. No undercoat required. Apply at least two full coats.

Touch dry in 4-6 hours Recoatable after 16 hours under normal conditions $(20^{\circ}\text{C} 50\% \text{ r/h}).$ Leave 48 hours before subjecting to heavy traffic.

Cleaning

Clean application equipment or spills with white spirit or Blackfriar **Brush Cleaner**

Limitations

New concrete must be left for 6 months to dry before painting. Not suitable for use over power-floated or Granolithic concrete. Do not apply to surfaces suffering from rising damp. Situations can arise where the steps may be slippery, such as a build up of moss, accumulation of wet leaves, during a heavy downpour and spillages of any liquids. Caution should be exercised when walking on any steps in these situations.
