

# Anti Slip Flortred



Johnstone's Anti Slip Flortred paint is a single pack finish which is suitable for use on internal concrete, steel and wooden floors in light to medium traffic areas as well as exterior use to highlight walkways, car park spaces and other markings. Not suitable for use on large external areas. It provides a seni gloss finish with a light aggregate for slip resistance. Tested to BS7976 Parts 1-3 for slip resistance, Anti Slip Flortred achieves a 'Low Slip Potential' classification according to the H.S.E. in both dry and wet conditions.

#### **RECOMMENDED USES**



Light to medium traffic areas, where slip resistance is essential, eg. walkways, doorways, ramps & steps. For exterior use to highlight walkways, car park spaces and other markings. Not suitable for large external areas.

Resistant to mild chemicals, water, oil and grease spillage. Slip resistant.

### COVERAGE



Johnstone's Anti Slip Flortred Paint will cover at the rate of approximately 11 square metres per litre depending on the nature and porosity of the surface being painted.

#### **DRYING TIME**



Recoatable after 16–24 hours under normal drying conditions.

### TRANSPORTATION & STORAGE

To avoid the risk of spillage always store and transport in a secure upright position. STORE AWAY FROM HEAT AND FLAME.

#### PREPARATION

All surfaces to be painted should be clean, dry and free from loose or flaking material. New concrete or cement should be allowed to mature for several months before painting. ## APPLICATION



Stir well before use. Apply by brush or roller which should be fully loaded for best results. Apply paint evenly by brush and avoid overspreading. Touch dry in 4-6 hours. Recoatable after 16-24 hours. To ease application, the first coat maybe thinnerd with up to 5% by volume of TC2 Thinner and Cleaner. Allow to dry overnight before applying a second coat, if required.

### CLEANING



Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Clean equipment immediately after use with TC2 Thinner and Cleaner. Replace lid firmly. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.
