It offers excellent coverage and application qualities with a drying time of 1-2 hours making the job easier to complete.

## COVERAGE



Johnstone's Dry Lining will cover approximately 12-14 square metres per litre depending on the nature and porosity of the surface being painted.

#### DRYING TIME



Touch dry in 1-2 hours. Recoatable after 2-4 hours.

## TRANSPORTATION & STORAGE

To avoid the risk of spillage, always store and transport in a secure, upright position. Protect from frost.

#### THINNER

Clean water.

## PREPARATION

## APPLICATION



Stir well. Easy to apply by brush or roller. Also suitable for application by spray. Seal new/bare surfaces with a coat of Dry Lining thinned up to 10% with clean water. Finish with two full coats of Dry Lining paint. Do not apply in temperatures below 10°C.

Plasterboards which have been initially coated with the board manufacturers specified primer/sealer should also be finish with two coats of Dry Lining paint.

#### CLEANING / AFTER USE



Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Replace lid firmly. Clean equipment immediately after use with warm soapy water and rinse thoroughly. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.

#### PRECAUTIONS

- Contains 1,2-benzisothiazol-3(2H)-one. May produce an allergic reaction.
- Safety data sheet available on request.
- If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Dispose of contents to a Waste Disposal Site in accordance with local/national regulations.
- Ensure good ventilation during application and drying.
- Do not breathe spray. Wear respiratory protection.
- Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.
- IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes.
  Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do.
  Continue rinsing.
- IF ON SKIN: wash with plenty of soap and water. Do not use solvent thinners or White Spirit.
- IF SWALLOWED: Call a POISON CENTRE or doctor if you feel unwell.
