**PROPERTIES** 

**Drying time** Under normal drying conditions recoatable after 3 hours. Allow for adequate ventilation

during the drying period.

Finish Silk.

**Composition** Pigment: Titanium Dioxide, coloured pigments and extenders.

Binder: Vinyl acetate copolymer.

Solvent: Water.

**Spreading rate** 15m<sup>2</sup> per litre on smooth surfaces.

Wet film thickness 66 micrometres at 15m<sup>2</sup> per litre.

**Dry film thickness** 21 micrometres at 15m<sup>2</sup> per litre.

**Volume solids** 31%. Brilliant White (other colours will vary).

Flash point Not applicable.

**VOC content** Low: 0.3 - 7.99%. VOC's (volatile organic compounds) contribute to atmospheric pollution.

Limitations For interior use only. Do not apply when air or substrate temperatures are likely to fall below

8°C or when the relative humidity is above 80% during application or the drying period.

**PREPARATION** 

New surfaces All surfaces must be sound, clean, suitably dry and free from anything that will interfere with

the adhesion of the materials to be applied. Powdery, polished plaster or dense surfaces should be primed with Permoglaze Primer Sealer thinned as per the container instructions. Porous surfaces should be mist coated with Permoglaze Vinyl Silk Emulsion thinned with up

to 15% clean water.

## Previously decorated surfaces

All surfaces must be sound, clean, suitably dry and free from anything that will interfere with the adhesion of the materials to be applied e.g. dirt, grease etc. Remove all loose, failing or suspect paint. Feather edges of sound paint. Remove all dust. Organic growth must be removed and the areas treated with Crown Trade fungicidal treatment. Patch prime bare and filled areas with Permoglaze Primer Sealer thinned as per the container instructions. Wash remaining sound paint with hot water and liquid detergent solution to remove any contaminants, frequently changing the water. Any glossy or eggshell surfaces should be wet abraded b provide a key. Rinse with clean water to remove all residues. Allow to dry. If after cleaning any areas still contaminated with substances likely to cause staining and/or bleeding, patch prime with one coat of Pemoglaze Primer Sealer thinned as per the container instructions. Bring forward patch primed areas with one coat of Pemoglaze Vinyl Silk Emulsion.

COATING SYSTEM Apply two coats as required.

**APPLICATION** Stir well before use. Apply by brush or roller. For airless spray (dilution may be required).

**CLEANING** Return surplus material to container. Wash with clean water immediately after use.

MAINTENANCE INFORMATION FOR CDM FILE

Between maintenance redecoration surfaces may be washed with a warm water and liquid

detergent solution to remove surface dirt.
